- Teasing, abusing or playing practical jokes on or causing hurt to a student
- Asking the student to do any act or perform something which a student will not carry out in the ordinary courses, willingly
- Ragging is totally prohibited in the institution, and anyone found guilty of ragging and/or
 abetting ragging, whether actively or passively, or being a part of a conspiracy to promote
 ragging, is liable to be punished, Ragging is a non-bail able, cognizable and punishable
 offence. Do not indulge in ragging.

Ragging is neither a means of familiarization, nor an introduction with fresher's, but a form of Psychopathic behavior. Ragging is a violation of Human Rights. Respect for Humanitarian Values. Ragging is a heinous crime, heavily punishable under the law. Ragging may spoil your career forever.
