Internship Programme Field Survey Report

On 25 November 2025, the Department of Economics organized a one-day field survey as part of an internship programme titled **“An Evaluation of the Gruha Jyoti Scheme: A Study of Chincholi Taluk.”** A total of 12 students, accompanied by **Dr. Ramakrishna B., Assistant Professor, Department of Economics**, participated in the field survey.

The primary objective of the survey was to assess the implementation, effectiveness, and socio-economic impact of the Gruha Jyoti Scheme on households in Chincholi Taluk. The programme was designed to provide students with practical exposure to field-based research and data collection techniques, thereby bridging the gap between theoretical knowledge and real-world application.

The survey was conducted in both rural and urban areas of Chincholi Taluk. The team interacted with various stakeholders, including government officials, local residents, and beneficiaries of the Gruha Jyoti Scheme. Students collected primary data using a structured interview schedule and questionnaire. Information was gathered regarding awareness of the scheme, eligibility criteria, benefits received, electricity consumption patterns, and the overall satisfaction level of beneficiaries.

During the field visit, students observed the living conditions of beneficiaries and gained valuable insights into the challenges and opportunities associated with the implementation of welfare schemes at the grassroots level. They also interacted with local authorities to understand the administrative procedures involved in the execution and monitoring of the programme.

The field survey commenced with the team departing from the college at 10:00 AM. Students were divided into small groups to ensure systematic data collection and wider coverage of the selected survey areas. Under the guidance and supervision of Dr. Ramakrishna B., the students successfully completed the survey activities by 4:00 PM and returned to the college on the same day.

The internship field survey proved to be a highly enriching learning experience. It enhanced the students' skills in communication, interviewing, data collection, observation, and

analytical thinking. The programme also helped them understand the practical aspects of socio-economic research and the importance of government welfare schemes in improving the quality of life of citizens. The collected data will be useful for further analysis and for evaluating the real-time effectiveness of the Gruha Jyoti Scheme in Chincholi Taluk.

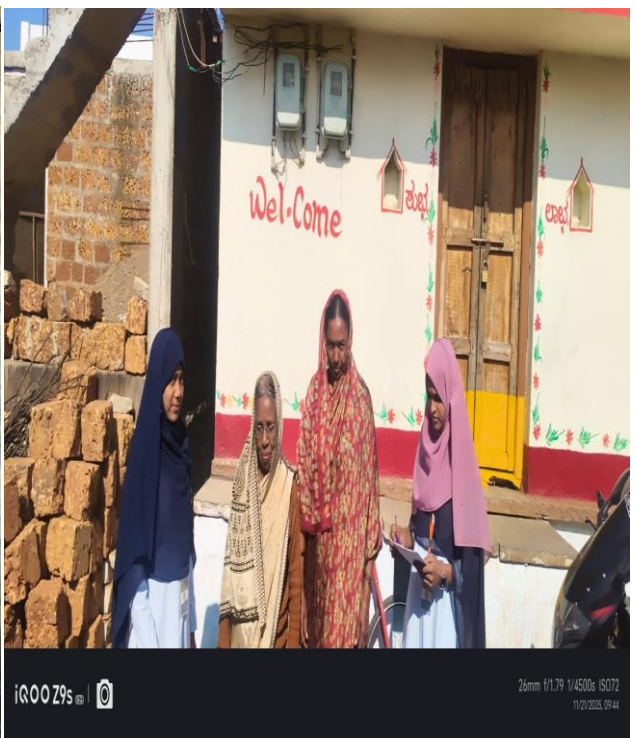
